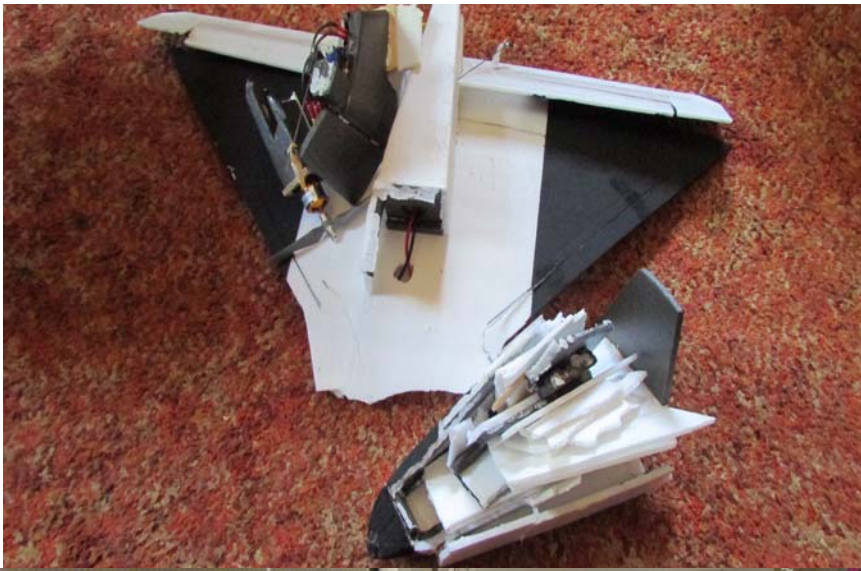
Verna won the raffle.
