October Presidents Message

If you haven't been out to the field in the last several weeks you have missed some really great flying weather!!

At the last meeting several topics were discussed that need to be presented to the membership;

Status of the current roster: Neil has worked on the membership list and we have gotten it up to date. The AMA sent us an updated list of KRCS members both paid and unpaid. My intent is to contact those on the list who are not currently AMA members. (AMA membership is required to belong to KRCS and fly at Creamery field) Same holds true for KRCS membership. You must be able to show both membership cards to fly at the field. Remember, KRCS dues are due by December 31st. A late fee of \$15 is applicable is not paid by January 31, 2017.

Replacement of current "impound area": Earlier in the year we thought we had a donation that would have allowed us to replace the old impound shed with a new "Walk in barn". The cost of a new barn is about \$2,600.

Unfortunately the donation fell through and we put the idea on hold. However; there appears to be enough members in favor of the move that we want to start a "fund drive" to generate the needed funds. Details to follow.

Replacement of the "safety fencing" on the flight line. This project will run about \$300 and is already started.

In response to some comments by several members I have written Bob Brown, president AMA. A number of members are questioning the value of the AMA for what they do for us. Please be aware that at the very least, AMA membership provides each member with access to \$2.5 million in liability insurance. This insurance is also a requirement of our landlord.

The October meeting will be at the field with November at Bob Krehling's plant off of Elmerton Ave.

October should be a good flying month so see you at the field.
