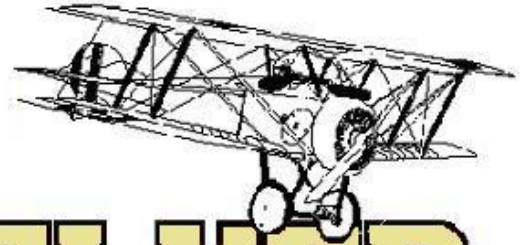

The Jet Rally at Maytown will be the Aug 1<sup>st</sup> weekend.

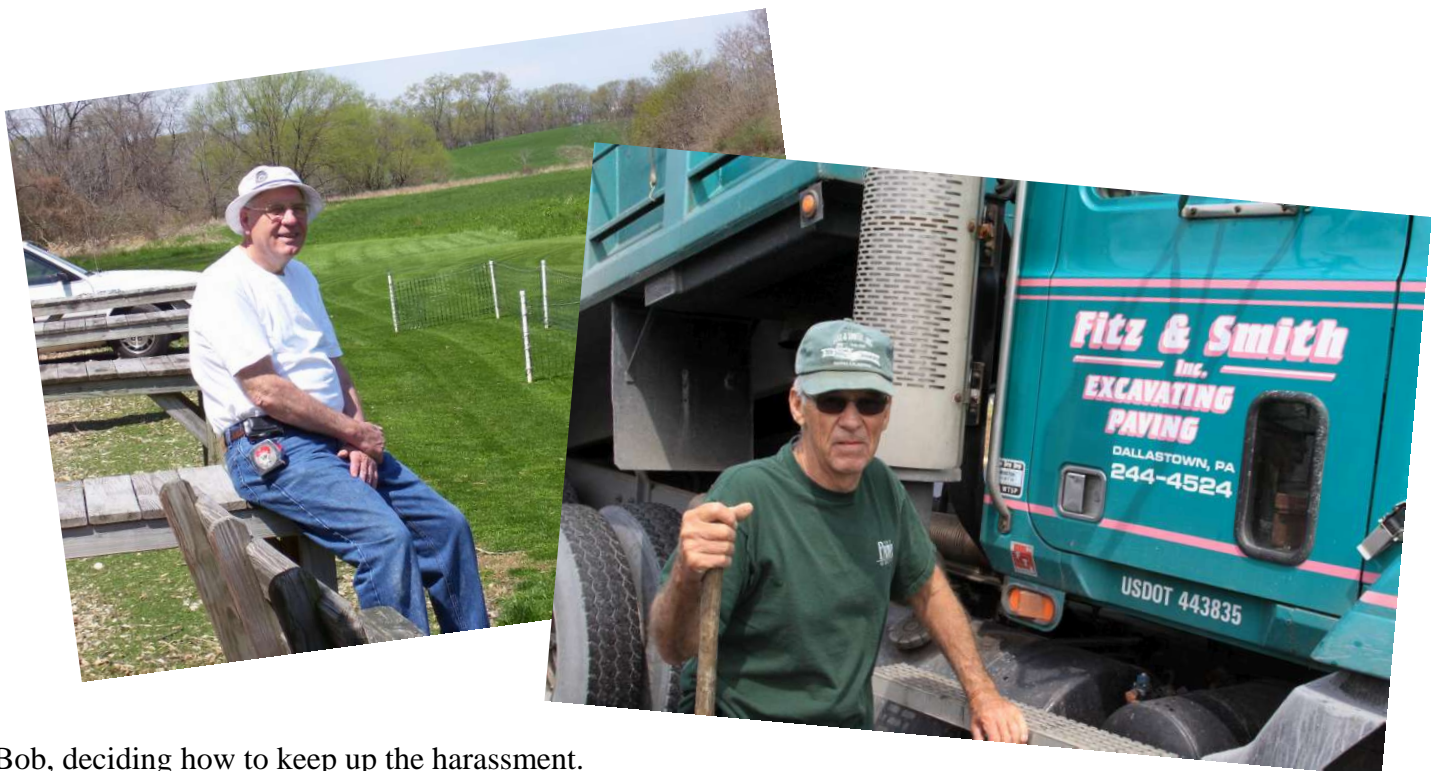
This is a "MUST SEE": event for all rc modelers.

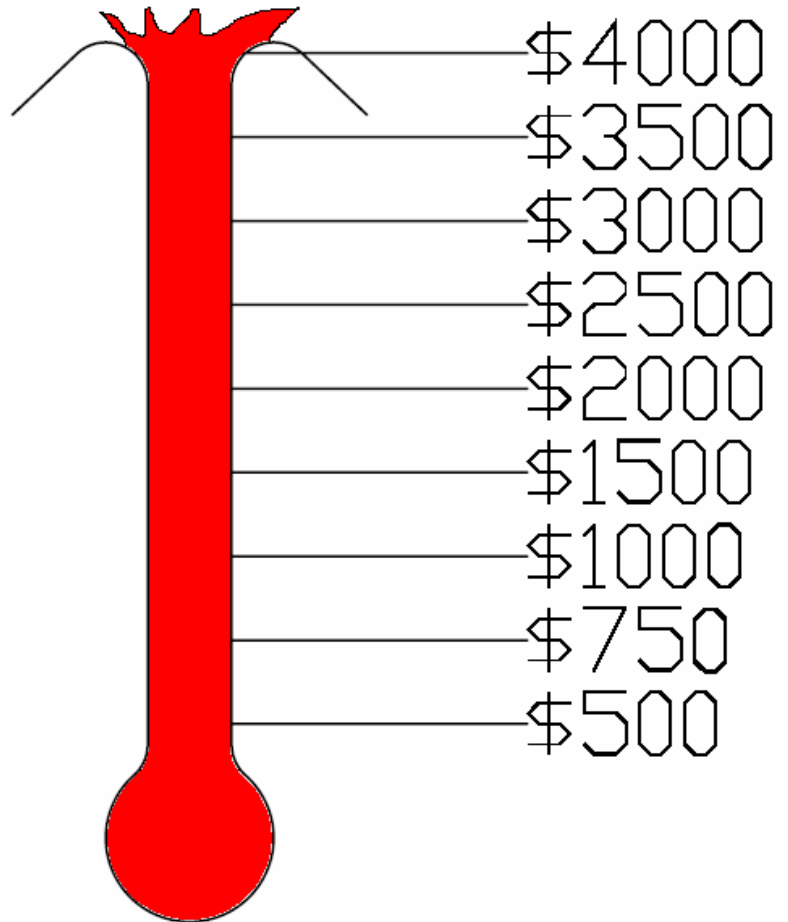
