Thanks to Harry and his group for a wonderful program.

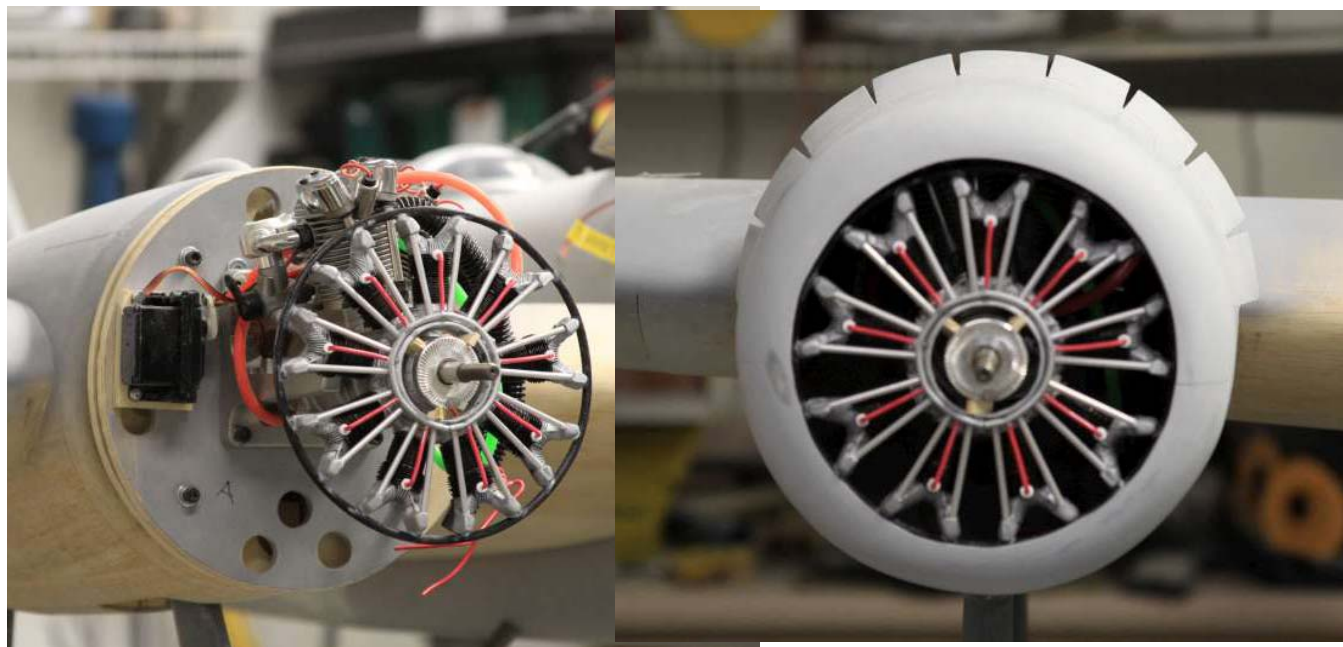
Henry Spangler once again won the 50/50 raffle.
